Winterim is a week-long, innovative curricular program offered in the upper school at Asheville Christian Academy to enhance learning opportunities and career experiences locally and abroad.

Many of our students explore a profession or career that they may be interested in pursuing through *internships*. Students are given the opportunity to connect with businesses in their communities to experience a profession first-hand before deciding on a college major or career path. They will shadow one or several workers within that office/field to gain a deeper understanding of some aspects of that career. This is an 'on the ground' type of experience for our students to be immersed in a work setting to explore if they might enjoy pursuing this as a career. We also hope that they can be of some service to their internship supervisors during this week in whatever ways may be appropriate.

Students are required to spend a minimum of **25 hours** during the week in their internships. They will also write a one-page paper regarding their experience.
