#### **Admissions Process**

Asheville Christian Academy is grateful for its warm community of families and looks forward to welcoming new international families and students each year. Eligible applications for international students entering grades 9 through 11 will be accepted through June 1 for the following school year that begins in August, as long as space is available. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that all steps in the admissions process are completed. Your application will be considered for admission only after all required documentation and application fee (Step 1) have been received by ACA. Before submitting the initial application, you will be required to pay a USD \$250 non-refundable application fee. You may pay this fee online with a working credit card or by wire transfer. If you need to pay with a wire transfer, please contact the Admissions Office prior to completing your application. We will need to receive your wire transfer and then waive the online fee before you may submit your application. All supporting documents, as well as the full amount of tuition must be received before beginning school in August.

#### A Community of Faith

Asheville Christian Academy is a covenantal Christian school, which means that we primarily partner with local Christian families who hold to our Statement of Faith and mission to teach from a biblical perspective. Not only are our classes of the highest academic standard, preparing all our students for university and beyond, but we also teach each class from the unique lens of biblical truth. We are a non-denominational organization, but we tend to align best with the evangelical perspective of the Christian faith. Above all, Jesus Christ is proclaimed as the Son of God, and we encourage our students to enter into a personal relationship with him as savior and redeemer. While we do not have the same faith requirements for our international students and families, we do ask that you be respectful of and open to the Christian faith.

#### **Academic Requirements**

Asheville Christian Academy is academically rigorous, preparing our students for university and beyond. Many of our classes are college-level classes. International students have an added challenge of studying in a language other than their primary learning language. The iTEP SLATE and TOEFL iBT are the preferred English proficiency tests for determining admissions.

- Applicants for 9<sup>th</sup> grade must submit a score of 3.5 on the iTEP SLATE or TOEFL iBT equivalent of 60 or higher.
- Applicants for 10<sup>th</sup> grade must submit a score of 4.0 on the iTEP SLATE or TOEFL iBT equivalent of 70 or higher.
- Applicants for 11<sup>th</sup> grade must submit a score of 4.5 on the iTEP SLATE or TOEFL iBT equivalent of 80 or higher.

We do not enroll international students in the 12<sup>th</sup> grade as first year students.

We require school transcripts to be evaluated by a third-party scoring agency. We will ask for your transcripts after the initial screening application. However, please note that high levels of academic success in addition to positive teacher recommendations must be documented in order to gain admission to Asheville Christian. We do provide English language support to our international students, but we expect students to be independent learners with regards to general academic subjects.

## Asheville Christian Academy Mission Statement and Statement of Faith

Asheville Christian Academy is a private Christian school. As a Christian school, Asheville Christian Academy has a specific philosophy of education which is rooted in its Mission Statement and Statement of Faith. The foundation for the Statement of Faith is the Bible. Asheville Christian Academy is an interdenominational school representing many churches of the evangelical, Protestant tradition.

Please read the Mission Statement and Statement of Faith and then sign below. Your signature does not necessarily mean that you fully agree with the Statements. Your signature means that you will allow your child to receive instruction based on the Statement of Faith.

#### **Mission Statement**

Seeking to serve Jesus Christ and uphold his pre-eminence, Asheville Christian Academy, in committed partnership with Christian parents, provides a Gospel-centered education to shepherd and inspire Christ-oriented lives within a community of grace and truth.

#### Statement of Faith

The basis of Asheville Christian Academy is the Word of God. In the light of this Word, we in our education program stand committed to the following:

- 1. The Bible is the Word of God, verbally inspired and inerrant as originally given, and is the supreme and final authority in faith and life.
- 2. God is Triune one eternal God existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Man is created in His image. Creation and providence are revelatory of Him.
- 3. Christ is God manifested in the flesh, born of a virgin. He lived a sinless life, suffered and died in our behalf; and He arose bodily from the grave, ascended, and is coming again in power and glory. Christ is the only mediator between God and man.
- 4. Regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely fundamental to Christian life and should be basic in all preparation for life. By God's grace only and through faith alone are our children and we saved from sin and its evil consequences.
- 5. The present ministry of the Holy Spirit is to indwell the Christian, enabling him to live a godly life.
- 6. There will be a bodily resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
- 7. The spiritual unity of believers is in our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 8. Parents are responsible for the education of their children. To bring them up in the Lord, they, through the agency of a Board, employ teachers who give evidence of a born-again life and who manifest ability to educate children morally and intellectually in the light of God's Word.
- 9. The pupils, being images of God, must be subject to His sovereign rule in their lives. Creation and providence (that which is taught), being God-revealing, must be presented as such. Such teaching makes for God-consciousness without which no Christian teaching is possible.
- 10. The doctrines stated in the first nine sections of Article II are essential and indisputable. Some other doctrines have been debated by evangelical Christians over the centuries. It is the school's policy that students not be deprived of robust examination of any Biblical text, but it is always to be done with respectful consideration of the various historical interpretations. Additionally, a student raising a question concerning such a doctrine should be referred to his or her parents or pastor.
